PREPARATIONS BEFORE OPERATION

PRECAUTIONS FOR DISCS

Placement

Put the unit where ventilation is good enough to prevent overheating. Never put the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources.

Put the unit horizontally, never put any heavy object on the unit.

To protect the laser, do not put the unit where there is dust. If there is dust on the laser, use a cleaning disc before use.

Condensation

Water will appear on the pickup lens in the following cases:


The unit is suddenly moved from a cold place to a warm place.

The unit had been used in a humid place. In this case, the unit will not work. Unload the disc

Cleaning Disc

A defective or soiled disc inserted into the unit can cause sound to drop out during playback.

Handle the disc by holding its outer edges.



Do not stick paper of tape on the surface.

Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or excessive heat.

Clean the disc before playback. Wipe the disc from the center outward with a cleaning cloth.

NEVER use solvents such as benzine or alcohol to clean the disc.

Do not use irregular shape discs (example: heart shaped, octagonal, etc.). They may cause malfunctions.

Cleaning the unit

Be sure to turn the unit off and disconnect the AC cord before maintaining the unit.

Wipe the unit with a dry soft cloth. If the surfaces are extremely dirty, wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-and-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, then wipe with a dry cloth.

Never use alcohol, benzine, thinner fluid or other chemicals. Do NOT use compressed air to remove dust.

Important Note

Before transporting the unit, remove any disc from the disc compartment.









!. ELECTRIC PLUG

Connection to auto-detect AC power supply(100~240V)

2. OPTICAL OUTPUT

Optical output for connection with a digital amplifier or receiver for surrounding sound. Please change the settings in the SETUP menu before use. * KARAOKE does not work while using OPTICAL output.

3. S-VIDEO OUTPUT Output for use in S-VIDEO input

4.VIDEO OUTPUT

5. COAXIAL OUTPUT

Coaxial digital output to connect with a digital amplifier or receiver for surrounding sound. Please change the settings in the SETUP menu before use. * KARAOKE does not work while using OPTICAL output.

Use to the switch amount the DVD mode, USB mode and CARD mode


6. SCORING

Support scoring function from outside audio inputs like amplifier or receiver. Please change the settings in the SETUP menu before use.

7. 5.1 CHANNEL AUDIO OUTPUT

RCA outputs for analog 5.1 audio outputs.

LOCATION OF CONTROLS



1. POWER

Turn on / off the MP3+G/CD+G Karaoke player

2.GUI SWITCH/PBC
In MP3G mode, can switch between windows and playback display mode.
PBC: This function is only available for video-cd version 2.0
or higher. The PBC function may differ by disc, with PBC on ,you can select items in the menu list using the PREVIOUS/NEXT keys.
When PBC off ,you can not select items in the menu list butyou can use the numeral keys directly or the PREVIOUS and NEXT keys.

3. DVD DISCPress to change to the disc mode.

4.USB PORT

Press to change to the usb mode if there is an external USB device.

5.SD CARD

Press to switch to sd card mode. In order for the soothly playback & record, please us high speed(Class 4 or up) SD card.

6.CLEAR

Used to delete programmed track.

7.REC VOL

To adjust the vocal volume while recording singing

8.MUSIC VOL

Increase or decrease the volume of music audio output.

9.DISPLAY

Press DISPLAY, the screen shows as follows according to the disc: Press DISPLAY the first time, and the screen shows the disc type, total item number playing item. PBC status and playing time of the item. When you press DISPLAY again, the screen will shut down.

10. AUDIO
Press to select an audio sound track option for DVD.

11. GOTODuring optical playback, press to perform a chapter,title or time search.

12. Direction (↑ ♣ ← →)Used for navigation within a selection menu.

13.RETURN

Utilized for operation with the PBC function. This button is used to return to a menu screen during play.

14. II PAUSE

Temporarily suspends playing. Video motion freezes and audio reproduction

15. RECORD

Press this button to start recording singing (audio Mp3 file only)from CD or VCD disc, or record MP3+G(A/V files) from CDG or MP3G disc files. You can change file name before start recording. To rip whole CDG or MP3G disc into MP3G files, press REPEAT button until the screen shows REC ALL, then press RECORD button. But you CAN'T edit file names in this mode. To rip single CDG or MP3Gtrack, press REPEAT button to select REPEAT(REC) ONE mode.

16. **≪** REW and **>>** FWD

Press ◀ REW/FWD ▶ to go into fast forward/fast reverse status. 77. SUBTITLE
Press to trun subtitles on/off or to select a subtitle language for DVD.

18. CUE/PASS

CUE: Switching between karaoke mode and DVD mode. In Karaoke mode, Player will pause after one track finished. In DVD Mode, all tracks will be played continually. Karaoke mode=Cue On. DVD mode=Cue Off Pass:When you play the DVD Disc,you can press the PASS button to jump over the advertiments and play the song or films directly.

19. SETUP
Press SETUP to get into SETUP menu

20. EQ Select from 7 types of equalizers or define your personal one.

21.ENTER

22.OPEN/CLOSE

Used to open and close disc tray

23. Number keys (1 to 9,0)
Used to specify a track number for playing, changing, or programming.
In PBC function operation, the number keys are additionally utilized for the selection of menu items.

24. PROGRAM Allow you to see 24. PROGRAM
Allow you to program a specific order. You can use up down left right to select the position where you edit. Press PLAY can play the specified program. And pressing CLEAR can clear all input number. You also can move HIGHLIGHT to the position of PLAY and CLEAR, and then you can use "SELECT" to execute its function.

25. KEY CONTROL buttons

Transposes the music key.

DOWN

button: used to flatten by a half tone. UP button: used to sharpen by a half tone

26. MPXSwitch between the left mono, the right mono or stereo sounds. Use to turn vocal on/off on multiplex CD+G,MP3+G, VCD disc.

27. MUTEPress to mute and cancel muteness

28. ANGLEPress ANGLE to select your desired watching angle when playing a multi-angle disc. There are four angle types, default is 1

29.REPEAT
Press this key to play selected item repeatedly. The screen shows as below:
(The function is only valid when PBC is off)
REP:[OFF] REP:[REP1] REP:[REP ALL].
30.TITLE

Used in DVD mode to go to the menu

31.MENU

For video-cd version 2.0 or higher, the PBC function may differ by disc. With PBC on, you can select items in the menu list using the previous/next keys and numeral keys. when PBC off, you cannot select items in the menu list but you can use the numeral keys directly or the PREVIOUS and NEXT keys.For DVD, you can enter main menu, the menu function may differ by disc. 32. ▶ PLAY

Starts to play the disc with/without the playback control function.

33. **■** STOP

34. I◀◀ PREV and ▶▶I NEXT Press to skip to next or previous track. see page 10 for detail.

35. ZOOM

Press ZOOM to turn on/off the zoom pan function. The picture will be displayed at the ratio selected by you. You can also move the picture to watch your desired viewing part via the directional keys. ZOOM1, ZOOM2, ZOOM3, ZOOM4, ZOOM1/2, ZOOM1/3, ZOOM1/4, ZOOM: OFF

36. A-B Press A-B first to set location A: REPEAT:A-, press again to set location B, and then playback will repeat during the two locations: REPEAT: A-B. Press A-B the third time to cancel the function and return to normal playback: REPEAT: CANCEL.

Press to play picture by picture, press PLAY to return to normal playback. 39. N/P
Change TV mode between NTSC←→ PAL.

INSERTING USB or CARD


Note:

 Try a different USB brand.
- USB 2.0 version USB and Class 4 or up SD card are recommend for smoothly playback and recording.
- This player supports USB in FAT and FAT32 formats only, Please reformat your USB memory stick to any one of these two format; However, If your usb memory stick is in FAT or FAT32 format and still doesn't work with the player, please reformat your USB memory stick.
- The player works with USB and SD card up to 16GB memory capacity.



CONNECTING TO AUDIO AND VIDEO COMPONENT


- . Make the connections as shown below if you want to enjoy video & sound through TV.


MAKING CONNECTIONS WITH 5.1 CHANNEL AMPLIFIER

You can connect your MP-1000 to 5.1 channel amplifier as below show:



POWER CONNECTION

When you have completed all other connections, plug your system's power cord into a standard AC outlet.



NOTE:

- Line voltage
- MP-1000 has universal power supply: 100V-240V~ 50/60Hz.
- Warning: To avoid electrical shock, do not connect the system to AC power until all other connections are completed.
- Caution: Make sure the voltage of the AC outlet matches the requirement of your karaoke system.

BASIC OPERATIONS

IMPORTANT:

Please make sure the unit is in the DISC mode to play the disc. To record, either USB device or SD card need to inserted.

PLAYING DISCS

1. Press POWER to turn on the system.



the tray door.



- 3. Place a disc in the compartment tray over the center hub, with the label facing out.
- 4. Push back the tray door to close the compartment.
- 5. The disc will be played automatically. To temporarily stop play, press PLAY/PAUSE. To resume play, press PLAY/PAUSE again.

Note:

- Do not apply excessive force to the tray door, or press the door while a disc is playing.

 Never place anything except a compact disc in the disc
- tray. Foreign objects can damage the player. Never place more than one disc on the disc tray at a time.
- During playback, if the system is subject to a sudden shock or jolt, the speed of rotation might change or some noises might be produce along with distortion of graphics. This is not a malfunction.

KARAOKE

USING MICROPHONES CONTROL

The system has two microphone jacks, so you can use the supplied microphone to sing along with your favorable recordings, connect an additional microphone for duets, or lead and background vocals. If you are connecting only one microphone, plug it into MIC 1. If you are adding a second microphone, plug it into MIC 2.

Plug a microphone into either MIC1 or MIC 2 SOCKETS.



KARAOKE

When a microphone is plugged into MIC 1 and MIC 2, the system mixes the music with your voice.

- 1. Press POWER to turn on the system. The POWER indicator turns on.
- 2. Load a Karaoke Disc in the CD compartment.
- 3. Press PLAY/PAUSE to start play.
- 4. Adjust MASTER VOLUME on the remote controller to the desired listening level.
- 5. Adjust Microphone volume on the remote controller to the desired singing level.
- 6. Sing directly into the microphone along with the music. 2. Press OPEN/CLOSE on the front panel or remote to open While playing a karaoke disc, you can read the lyrics of the songs, (MP3+G, CD+G only) which appear on the TV monitor. 7. Adjust ECHO level on the remote controller to the desired singing level.



REMOTE CONTROL

Putting batteries in the remote control


The battery compartment is located on the back of the remote control.

1. Open the lid of the remote control battery compartment.

2.Insert two size-AAA batteries.

Ensure that the batteries are inserted with the positive and negative terminals in the correct direction corresponding to the (+) and (-) marks in the battery compartment.

3.Install the lid of the remote control battery compartment.



BASIC SETUP OPERATIONS

SYSTEM SETUP

Unload the Disc then:

Press Setup KEY to open the Setup MENU.

The **"SYSTEM SETUP"** will showed first.

Contains: TV SYSTEM, SCREEN SAVER, VIDEO, TV TYPE, PASSWORD, RATING,

DEFAULT and EXIT SETUP.

TV SYSTEM

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼] to choose "TV SYSTEM" .
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY $[\P / A]$ to select the TV system [NTSC/ PAL/AUTO].

SCREEN SAVER

- 1) Press **Direction KEY** [▼/▲] to choose "**SCREEN SAVER**".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select "ON" or " OFF".
- 4) Press ENTER to confirm it.

If choose "ON", the DVD will play the "SCREEN SAVER" when it stands by.

VIDEO

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "VIDEO".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select Video Output Mode.
- 4) Press **ENTER** to confirm it.

*NOTE: The Output Mode contains: YUV/TV-RGB/P-SCAN/YPBPR/PC-VGA/S-VIDEO. Make sure TV and DVD was in RIGHT connection before setting.

• TV TYPE

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "TV TYPE".
- 2) Press **Direction KEY** [▶] to show **Sub-MENU**.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select TV TYPE.
- 4) Press **ENTER** to confirm it.

*NOTE: TV TYPE contains: : 4:3PS, 4:3LB or 16:9. Some discs can not be played as your selection because that disc was not recording in the same format.

PASSWORD

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "PASSWORD".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press the Numeric KEY to input new password if necessary.
- 4) Press ENTER to confirm it.
- *NOTE: The password should be four numbers. The default password is "0000".

RATING

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "RATING".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [\sqrt{A}] to select the "RATING" if necessary.
- 4) Press ENTER to confirm it.
- *NOTE: "RATING" can be set only in UNLOCK PASSWORD state. This function should be supported by the DISC.

LANGUAGE SETUP

Unload the Disc then:


Press Setup KEY to open the Setup MENU.

Press Direction KEY [◄/▶] to select the "LANGUAGE SETUP". The Sub-MENU contain:

OSD LANGUAGE

- 1) Press Direction KEY [$\blacktriangledown/\blacktriangle$] to choose "OSD LANGUAGE".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select ENGLISH or CHINESE.
- 4) Press **ENTER** to confirm it.

AUDIO LANGUAGE

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "AUDIO LANGUAGE".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select the Language [CHINESE, ENGLISH, JAPAN , FRENCH , SPANISH ,PORTUGUESE , LATIN or GERMAN].
- 4) Press ENTER to confirm it.

• SUBTITLE LANGUAGE

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "SUBTITLE LANGUAGE".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select the Language [CHINESE, ENGLISH, JAPAN , FRENCH , SPANISH ,PORTUGUESE , GERMAN or OFF].
- 4) Press ENTER to confirm it.

• MANU LANGUAGE

- 1) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to choose "MANU LANGUAGE".
- 2) Press Direction KEY [▶] to show Sub-MENU.
- 3) Press Direction KEY [▼/▲] to select the Language [CHINESE, ENGLISH, JAPAN, FRENCH, SPANISH, PORTUGUESE, LATIN or GERMANI.

- *NOTE: AUDIO LANGUAGE, SUBTITLE LANGUAGE, and MENU LANGUAGE should be support by DISK function.



MP3+G FUNCTION

1. What Is MP3+G The MP3+G is MP3 based karaoke file format, consists of two files, the audio track compressed to the MP3 format and a separate cdg file that contains the graphic data.

These two files combined occupy about one eighth the disc space of a standard CDG track.

This is a great way to back up your karaoke discs to your hard drive or CD's.

Up to now MP3+G treated as for the personal Computer only, now MP-1000 can easily and quickly rip and play MP3+G Karaoke File.

2. Where to get MP3+G files

Your can generate MP3+G files from CDG disc by using MP-1000 recording function.

See page 6 RECORDING function for more detail.

Also, there are huge MP3+G files scattered on the Internet, just type MP3+G on your favorite website, ex)google, vahoo.

3. How you can make your own MP3+G Disc or USB Once you get MP3+G files, burn those files using regular blank CDR,CDRW.

Burning so easy. Even standard window XP or Vista Support this.

ex)just select you want by left mouse button, then click right, select send to your CD burner. then burn.

Using USB memory is the fastest and easist way to play.

Just put your favorite MP3+G files to your USB memory then plug in. that's it.

4. How You can play MP3+G files with MP-1000

Everything successful by 3rd step above? Now you ready to play with MP-1000

Just put your disc or USB, navigate using arrow keys on the song list, then hit the ENTER key.

You want to record your voice with music? just hit the record button on the remote or MP-1000 front panel. If you hit the record button while choosing CD+G or MP3+G disc(file), machine will generate MP3+G files under RECORD folder in either USB drive or SD CARD. Mean you can record your singing with

5. MP3+G RECORDING

While playing MP3+G song of disc, simply press RECORD.

Then automatically record onto USB in MP3 format. If want to stop recording, also press RECORD, a screen go back to MP3+G OSD. After finish recording, it will be returned to MP3+G OSD automatically.

6. How to rip songs from CDG/MP3G disc?

You can choose to rip single track or whole disc by press Repeat off or Repeat all on the remote while playing songs. Then press record button to start ripping songs. Remember to turn off the microphone while ripping disc otherwise your vocal will also be recorded.

Beside, You can only edit recording song name when ripping single song but not ripping whole disc.



FILE/MP3+G SONG LIST Interface switching

In USB or SD card mode, if you press GUI Switch button, It change the interface between file window and MP3+G song list windows.



SKIPPING TRACKS

While the disc is stopped, you can skip up or down to select a specific track by pressing PREV I◄◄ / NEXT ▶▶I To play the selected track, press PLAY.

While a disc is playing, press PREV ◄ once to skip back to the beginning of the current track.

Repeatedly press PREV ◄ to search backward to the beginning of the desired track.

Repeatedly press Next ▶▶I to search forward to the beginning of the desired track.

- 1. Press PROGRAM on the remote control, the program menu appears on the TV screen.
- 2. Use the navigation keys (▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶) to select the track for VCD/CD/CDG and press OK, the track or title / chapter is added in the program play list.
- 3. Repeat the above steps to add more tracks title/ chapter in the program list.
- 4. Press PLAY/PAUSE or highlight the PLAY on the screen and press OK to start programmed playback.

Programmed Play automatically stops at the end of the last programmed track or title/chapter. Highlight the CLEAR on the screen and press OK to delete the last track or title/chapter in the program list. Highlight the CLEAR ALL on the screen and press OK to erase the entire programmed sequence.

NOTE:

- In playing back the VCD with PBC, you cannot set Program playback.
- The program is cancelled when you open the disc tray or turn the power off.

SEARCH PLAY


While the disc is playing, press REV ◀◀ /FWD▶▶ to search backward or forward. Press PLAY to resume the normal playback.

Each time the REV◀◀/FWD▶▶ button is pressed, the speed of backward / forward search changes at speed: x2, x4, x8, x20.


While playing a disc, press REPEAT on the remote control repeatedly to choose a repeat play mode.



REPEAT A SPECIFIC SECTION

A-B repeat playback allows a specific section to be repeated.

- While the disc is playing, press A-B button to set the beginning of the section (point A) to be played repeatedly.
- Press A-B button again to set the end of the section (point B) to be played repeatedly.
- The unit will then immediately begin replaying the selection (A to B) repeatedly.

 Press A-B button again to clear the programmed repeat playback and return to normal playback.

Note:

• The A-B repeat function can only be used within the same title or track. If points A and B are defined in different titles or tracks, A-B repeat is can celled.

FLIPPING AND ROTATING STILL PICTURE

Press the navigation keys (\blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown / \blacktriangleright) to flip the still picture on the TV.

▲ : flip the picture vertically.

▼ : flip the picture horizontally.

► : rotate the picture 90° clockwise.
